In a Nutshell

Leading a Digital School 2015 is a digital education technology conference that examines 3 mega themes in depth. The mega themes

BYOT (2 keynotes and plenty of other sessions to choose from) – this concept is still in its formative stage but gaining momentum in K-12 schools. Lee and Levins (2012) in their book “Bring your own technology” suggest that it is an educational development and supplementary school technology resourcing model where the home and school collaborate in arranging for students to use their own digital technology in the classroom. They say this assists teaching and learning, the organisation of schooling and complementary education outside the classroom.

Does it? What is the link to Flipping Learning? Attend the conference to explore the BYOT theme in depth.

Flipping Learning (2 keynotes and plenty of other sessions to choose from) – one definition (there are many others) is that it is a pedagogical approach in which direct instruction moves from the traditional classroom space to an individual learning space. This allows the classroom space to be transformed into a dynamic, interactive learning environment where the teacher guides students as they apply concepts and engage creatively in the subject matter.

What are the many ways in which this can be done? Attend the conference to explore this theme in depth.

Change Now (2 keynotes and plenty of other sessions to choose from) – we have included this theme to provide a blueprint and inspiration for moving forward in your school for your students with what you have gleaned about BYOT and Flipping Learning.
